### Cycle Rides from Trewince Holiday Lodges

These are all available from the Information Centre within the Reception.

Ride	Distance (approx.)	Description
1	14.9km / 9.3 miles, 300m ascent	St Mawes, St Just and across the Roseland Peninsula
2	37km / 23 miles, 600m ascent	St Mawes, Falmouth and around the estuaries
3	41km / 25.6 miles, 520m ascent	St Mawes, Falmouth and Lizard Point
4	49.4km / 30.9 miles, 910m ascent	Estuaries and across the Roseland Peninsula, back along the coast
5	53km / 33 miles, 1040m ascent	Trewince to Mevagissey then back along the coast

- All distances within these routes are approximate and maps are not to scale.
- Ordnance Survey Explorer map or similar should be used in conjunction with these routes
  - Timings are not given as these are dependent on individual's ability and conditions
    - Any feedback regarding the walk descriptions would be appreciated

### Ferry Details

For the **Place to St Mawes** crossing care will be needed to board the ferry in most tidal conditions, but especially during low tide, there is a small charge for cycles on this small boat and due to the size of vessel are only able to accommodate one or two bikes per trip. For **St Mawes to Falmouth** this is a little easier as the ferry is much larger, there is no charge on these boats for bikes. However, should you be going in a large party please contact them first to ensure they can assist with loading and unloading. Panniers may need to be removed for the crossing to allow secure storage. The **Helford River** ferry which has run since the Middle Ages now only runs from 1st April through to 31st October. There is a small charge for cycles on this small boat and due to the size of the vessel it can only accommodate one or two bikes per trip.
